

## **Conflict minerals statement**


IKT Electronics Ltd is committed to responsible sourcing practices and ethical supply chain management. As a contract electronics manufacturer, we recognize our responsibility to respect human rights and contribute to the avoidance of conflict and human rights abuses in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and adjoining countries.

We conduct due diligence on our supply chain to identify the presence of conflict minerals, including gold (Au), tantalum (Ta), tin (Sn), and tungsten (W), as outlined in the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.

As a contract electronics manufacturer, we do not use or sell raw materials. Our due diligence measures include obtaining proves from our suppliers to trace the origin of the above mentioned minerals. We require all our suppliers to review their supply chain and provide the necessary evidence material to assure that they don't use conflict minerals sourced from mines in conflict areas. If we identify any instances of non-compliance, we take immediate corrective actions, including engagement with suppliers to address issues and, if necessary, seeking alternative sources of supply.

IKT Electronics Ltd remains dedicated to upholding ethical standards and promoting responsible mineral sourcing practices throughout its supply chain.
